The main ingredients of SBP are swarn prashan (gold nanoparticle), gou ghrita (cow ghee), madhu (honey), and other medhya dravyas (drugs that enhance intellect and memory). A query session was held where parents cleared their doubts about the dosage, age, components, and side effects of Swarn Prashan. The parents found the session effective and informative. At the end, our headmistress, Ms. Pooja Bhardwaj, gave a vote of thanks to Dr. Preeti Chhabra and concluded the awareness workshop.
